





## Call to contribute to a Special Collection

## "Broad-scale classification of European vegetation"

in Vegetation Classification and Survey



The European Vegetation Survey and the IAVS' gold open access journal "Vegetation Classification and Survey" are proud to launch a joint Special Collection dedicated to the broad-scale classification of European vegetation. We welcome both original research papers and review papers from the national to the continental scale. Presenters at the 33rd conference of the European Vegetation Survey in Perugia are especially welcome to submit papers related to their presentations, but the Special Collection is open to any paper fitting its scope.

Vegetation Classification and Survey is an international, peer-reviewed, online journal on plant community ecology published on behalf of the International Association for Vegetation Science (IAVS) together with its sister journals, Journal of Vegetation Science (JVS) and Applied Vegetation Science (AVS). It is devoted to vegetation survey and classification at any organizational and spatial scale and without restriction to certain methodological approaches. It is a specially attractive venue for vegetation survey papers, as long articles are welcome, and offers free reproduction of color figures.

Vegetation Classification and Survey is indexed in Web of Science, with a **Journal Impact Factor** in 2024 of **3.0**, and placed in the second quartile (**Q2**) of all its subject categories. In **Scopus** it has a CiteScore for 2024 of **3.6**, and is placed into **Q1** in all its subject categories.

The publication of the SC is scheduled for issue 7 of VCS, along 2026, but papers with longer peer-review process might be published in VCS issue 8, in 2027.

## **Procedure and deadlines**

- Until 30 September 2025: Please submit your abstract to Idoia Biurrun (idoia.biurrun@ehu.eus). The abstract must follow the VCS Author Guidelines
- Until 15 October 2025: Authors will be notified whether their planned work is eligible for submission
- Until 31 January 2026: Submission of invited papers. If the number of eligible papers should be too low for a Special Collection, authors will be offered to submit their manuscript as a regular paper
- Manuscripts will undergo a double-blind peer review process and be published on a oneby-one basis once accepted
- We anticipate that we will conclude the whole Special Collection at the end of 2026 or beginnings of 2027
