

Measure of the Dean of the Faculty of Science of MU No. 2/2020

Measures regarding the epidemiological situation.

In accordance with Art. 28(1) of Act No. 111/1998 Sb., on Higher Education Institutions and the Modification and Amendment of Other Acts (Higher Education Act), as subsequently amended (hereinafter referred to as the "Higher Education Act"), I hereby issue this directive: (effective as of May 25, 2020)

Article 1

Student's presence within the premises of the Faculty of Science.

- (1) Beginning May 25, 2020 all forms of direct contact instructions can be carried out. Hygienic measures, as stipulated by the Ministry of Health, must be fulfilled.
- (2) Where possible, the course guarantors shall allow students to study using electronic materials or use distance learning.
- (3) State examinations (bachelor's, master's, PhD examination, doctoral) or the defense of dissertations can take place, provided the Hygienic measures, as stipulated by the Ministry of Health, are fulfilled.
- (4) Students that have not provided individual declaration of the absence of symptoms of a viral infectious disease during the previous two weeks (https://is.muni.cz/auth/koronavirus_prohlaseni?lang=en;setlang=en) are not allowed to be present in class, this declaration is not needed to enter MU buildings.
- (5) The business hours of the Student affairs and Doctoral Studies Departments are Mondays 12pm -2:30pm, and Wednesdays 12:30pm-2:30pm. Other days are appointment only. Students are required to wear a face mask to enter these offices; social distancing (min 1.5 meters) is in effect.

Article 2

Measures regarding travels abroad for students and employees

- (1) Business trips abroad, including departures for a stay abroad within the Erasmus program, internships, and other work stays, are possible only if the destination allows such stays.
- (2) Arrivals of foreign guests, employees and academics Government Resolution No. 511 allows foreign employees or other persons who will work at MU or "perform economic activities" to cross the land border into the Czech Republic. This applies only to EU citizens. For persons from other countries, embassies abroad do not accept any applications for entry. These persons may arrive on presentation of a negative test and a certificate confirming economic activity.

Restrictions on free movement within the Czech Republic apply for all these persons for a period of 14 days from entry into the Czech Republic, with the exception of trips to work, trips necessarily to procure basic necessities, trips to the doctor, trips for urgent official matters, trips back to his residence, funerals.

(3) All employees returning from abroad, including private trips, must contact the HR department before entering the workplace for the time period this measure is in effect.

Article 3

Final provisions

- (1) This measure is in effect until September 30, 2020.
- (2) Interpretation of this directive is the responsibility of the Faculty Bursar.
- (3) Exceptions to this measure shall be granted by the Dean.
- (4) This Directive is effective on the day of its publishing.
